Recognizing the Gifts God Is Growing in Me

Your impact does not begin someday in the future.
God is already using your life, your story, your gifts, and
your presence in ways you may not fully see yet.

You are becoming.
Your life matters.
And your impact is already greater than you realize.

Step 1: Recognize the Seasons That Shaped You

Think about the seasons that have most shaped your heart, perspective, and faith.

Reflect: What seasons most shaped who I am today?

What did those seasons grow in me?
(e.g., compassion, wisdom, patience, resilience, faith)

Step 2: Identify the Gifts God Is Growing in You

Sometimes the gifts God gives us feel so natural that we overlook them.

Pause and reflect: What comes naturally to me when caring for or helping others?

Step 3: Notice Your Everyday Impact

Kingdom impact often happens quietly.

Reflect on the small ways your life may already be affecting others.

Reflection: When do I feel most aligned with who God created me to be?

Step 4: Shift from Survival to Purpose

Sometimes we spend so long surviving that we forget God may also be calling us to live with purpose, freedom, and intention.

Pause and ask: What would change if I fully believed God could use my life right now?

Step 5: Prayer + Surrender: Write a simple prayer asking God to help you walk confidently in the gifts and purpose he is growing in you.

God, help me recognize the ways You are using my life to reflect Your love and impact others.

Closing Reminder

You do not need a massive platform to make a Kingdom impact. Sometimes the greatest impact happens through kindness, consistency, encouragement, faithfulness, and simply showing up with love.

Final Truth

God is still shaping you.
